Process for review of materials for life-threatening health conditions:

1. Review:

Has parent/guardian returned a completed and signed CIS? Yes No

2. Review:

Has the Life-Threatening Health Condition box been checked? Yes No

If No, attach this form to all health related forms for this student and forward to the school nurse or health technician.

If Yes, give appropriate packet to parent and mark:

- Allergy (Bee Sting)
- Allergy (Food, Other)
- Asthma
- Diabetes
- Other

Tell the parent that the student may not attend school until all forms in the packet have been completed and returned to the school nurse.
