



**2009-10**  
**IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**  
**GRADES 1 – 5**

(\*Grade 1 – see below)  
(\*\*Grades 2 and 3 – see below)

Washington State Law (RCW 28A.210.060-170) requires that all children have a completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) on file at the school they attend AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.

The exact date (month/day/year) each vaccine dose was given is required.

**STUDENT CANNOT ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL THE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.**

This law requires proof of one of the following:

1. Full immunization consisting of
  - 3 doses Hep B (Hepatitis B)
  - 3 doses DTaP/DT/Td/Tdap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis), with last dose on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
  - 4 doses IPV or OPV (Polio), if all doses given before 4<sup>th</sup> birthday  
3 doses IPV or OPV (Polio), if last dose given on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday
  - 2 doses MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), first dose given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and second dose at least 28 days after the first dose

**\*Grade 1 must also have received the following:**

- **2 doses Varicella (Chickenpox), first dose given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and second dose at least 28 days after the first dose or Verification of disease history signed by the health care provider or Laboratory report of blood test (titer) showing serological proof of immunity**

**\*\*Grades 2 and 3 must also have received the following:**

- **1 dose Varicella (Chickenpox), given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday, or parent reported history of disease**
2. The initiation of and compliance with a schedule of immunization.
  3. A Certificate of Exemption (COE) completed and signed by the parent/guardian for personal/philosophical or religious exemption.
  4. A Certificate of Exemption (COE) completed and signed by the health care provider for medical exemption.
