



**2009-10**  
**IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**  
**PRESCHOOL**

Washington State Law (RCW 28A.210.060-170) requires that all children have a completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) on file at the school they attend AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.

The exact date (month/day/year) each vaccine dose was given is required.

**STUDENT CANNOT ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL THE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS ARE MET.**

This law requires proof of one of the following:

1. Full immunization consisting of
  - 3 doses Hep B (Hepatitis B)
  - 4 doses DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
  - 4 doses Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type b) by 16 months of age (Hib is not given after 5 years of age.) or  
3 doses Hib if only 2 doses given before 12 months of age or  
2 doses Hib if both doses received between 12-15 months of age or  
1 dose Hib if the only dose was given on or after 15 months of age
  - 4 doses PCV (Pneumococcal) by 16 months of age (PCV is not given after 5 years of age.) or  
3 doses PCV if only 2 doses given before 12 months of age or  
2 doses PCV if both doses received between 12-24 months of age or  
1 dose PCV if the only dose was given on or after 24 months of age
  - 3 doses IPV (Polio)
  - 1 dose MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday
  - 1 dose Varicella (Chickenpox) given on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday or  
Verification of disease history signed by the health care provider or  
Laboratory report of blood test (titer) showing serological proof of immunity
2. The initiation of and compliance with a schedule of immunization.
3. A Certificate of Exemption (COE) completed and signed by the parent/guardian for personal/philosophical or religious exemption.
4. A Certificate of Exemption (COE) completed and signed by the health care provider for medical exemption.
